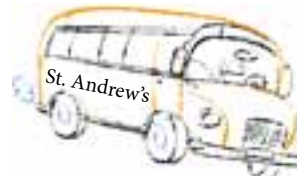

Former President George W. Bush presented TMM with the number 541 'Daily Point of Light' Award in 1991 — come and join us as we experience the love of Christ in the rural South. 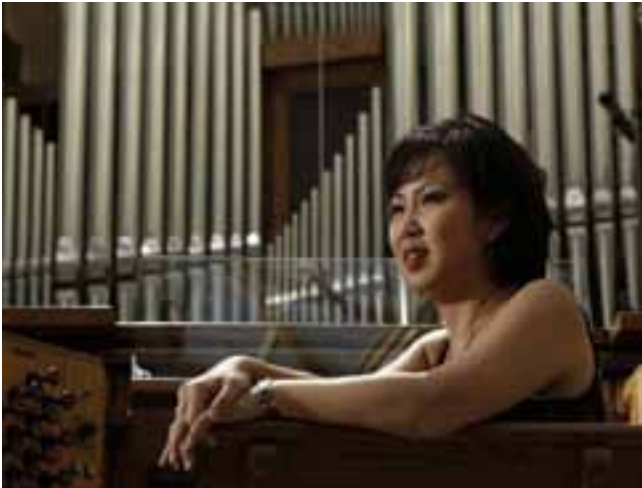
