**Gathering Together**

1. Describe a time when you felt in awe of God or felt like you were standing on “holy ground” (3:5).

**Reading the Text ~ Read: Exodus 3:1-14**

2. What part of the sermon, scripture passage, or *The Story* this week was particularly important or meaningful to you? What questions do you have for the group?
3. How does God display His concern and love for His people after hearing their cries and groaning (3:8-10)?
4. In ancient culture names often revealed character. God tells Moses His name revealing Himself as YHWH, which is related with “to be”, and can be translated “I AM WHO I AM” (3:14). What does this name for God tell us about Him?

**Seeing the Big Story ~ Chapters 4-5 *The Story***

5. Moses has trouble believing God could use him. This week, journal/share with your group the areas in your life where you feel insecure. How does Moses’ story intersect with yours?
6. During the Israelites’ exodus from slavery in Egypt, they consistently worried about their future, doubting God would provide. How did God provide for them in large and small ways? How has God graciously provided for your essential needs?
7. The Ten Commandments lead God’s people to a life of everyday holiness, with a close relationship with the Lord. Which commandments do you think are most difficult to keep? How does God’s best way to live impact how you live each day?

**Living It Out**

8. Moses was intrigued by God’s uncommon display of the burning bush. What drew you to first get to know God? What is drawing you now into closer relationship with Him?
9. God displays many miracles in the deliverance of the people from Egypt. Do you believe God performs miracles today? Why or why not?
10. Moses doubted his own qualifications and abilities, but God responded with the guarantee of His presence. How would you most like to identify with Moses—receiving mission from God, experiencing God’s presence sustaining you, being used despite your qualifications, etc.?

**Prayer:** Show each of us the mission You have for us, overcome our self-doubt with Your presence...
