The Parent/Child staff members are committed Christians, trained in early childhood development. The staff understands the importance of Christian parenting.

A TYPICAL DAY

A typical day in Parent/Child begins with free play, which includes both inside and outside developmentally appropriate and stimulating activities.

Each child has an opportunity to decide on which activity they would like to participate in with their parents. Parents are always close by and can join in the playtime with their child.

At the conclusion of free play, everyone comes together as a group for snack time. (Except Thursday 2 and 3 classes)

After snack, the children continue to play with two Parent/Child teachers, while the parents go to their own discussion and fellowship time led by the Parent/Child director and guest speakers.

*The youngest Thursday 2 and 3 classes function as a supportive, fun playgroup. Free play is followed by an enriching, age-appropriate music time just before class concludes. All classes conclude with a music and movement time.
