Our desire is to connect people with a common commitment to follow Christ and to come alongside each other as his disciples. Here are some areas in which this can happen:

Discipleship:

There is a great need for women and men who are willing to model, teach, and encourage others in their daily walk. This might be one-on-one, or it could be a small group that is focused on a specific topic such as parenting, relationships, or work. Are you willing to share your faith and life experiences with others in an intentional and loving way? *Discipleship involves a time commitment for up to one year.*

Christian Education:

Some members of our community are new in their faith and are just getting to know the Bible. Others have questions about how it applies to their own lives. We are looking for small group leaders who are willing to help others understand the amazing narrative and foundational truths found in God’s Word in an informal, personal way.

Children’s Ministry:
