Invitation To Reflect

Day One *Trusting God with “More Than We Imagine”*

Scripture: Ephesians 3:20-21; Philippians 1:6

Lord, You have been faithful to St. Andrew's for more than 75 years. We believe You are not finished with us. Grow in us a holy expectation for what You can do next—ministries that reach new neighborhoods, deeper discipleship across generations, and a campus filled with stories of transformed lives. Help us think bigger than maintenance and dream with You about multiplication.

Day Two *Creating a Welcoming Campus for All Generations*

Scripture: Psalm 78:4-7; Isaiah 58:12

Father, as we re-envision entrances, meeting spaces, and common areas, make every doorway an invitation into Your presence. Let this entire physical space be filled with spiritual power. Holy Spirit, in Your grace help us show hospitality to first-time visitors, inspire belonging in long-time members, and facilitate collaboration for staff and volunteers. May each square foot be used to disciple children, form friendships, and launch new ministries for Your glory and the sake of Your Name.



Day Three *One Church, Many Expressions of Worship*

Scripture: John 17:20-23; Psalms 133:1

Jesus, as our sanctuary is adapted to honor You, no matter the style, the substance is the same. You are King. You are Beautiful. You are Savior. You are our only Hope and our only need. Would You weave our hearts together? We picture Sundays where grandparents and grandchildren sing side by side; where the room is a sacred space and the sacred people who fill it both point to Your glory. Make our worship a living witness that Your Church transcends style and generation.

Day Four *Extending Christ's Care Beyond 600 St. Andrews Road*

Scripture: Matthew 25:35-40; Jeremiah 29:7

Compassionate God, give us courage to take Your love into the places where it's most needed. Help us to see Spirit-led opportunities for the plans that can communicate the Gospel in word and deed with our neighbors. Guide our partnerships with local ministries so that together we close gaps in services and open doors for the Gospel. As we plant a physical presence beyond our walls, plant hope in hearts that may never attend our campus.

Day Five *Raising Up a Generation of Disciples and Leaders*

Scripture: Deuteronomy 6:6-7; 1 Timothy 4:12

Lord, breathe new life into our Youth Center, Family Center and small-group spaces. Let technology upgrades, flexible study areas, and redesigned rooms become catalysts for mentoring relationships, Bible study and mission projects. Produce the fruit that only You can from our faithful hospitality and witness. May students find safe places to wrestle with faith and be trained as servant leaders who will shape their schools, workplaces and future families with the Gospel.

Day Six *Shaping Culture through Faithful Work and Creative Expression*

Scripture: Matthew 5:13-16; Colossians 3:23-24

Creator God, as we expand the St. Andrew's Creative Institute and launch the Faith, Work, and Economics Initiative, equip artists, professionals, and entrepreneurs to see their craft and career as worship. Use us to influence culture with beauty, integrity and hope, and to reflect Your creative and redemptive power to a world in search of truth.

Day Seven *Joyful Generosity and Faithful Stewardship*

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 9:6-8; 1 Chronicles 29:10-14; Psalm 24:1

Father, every resource we have is Yours. Stir in us a spirit of joyful generosity to meet the goals of \$25 million for campus renewal, \$8 million for community outreach, and \$2 million for culture-shaping initiatives. May our giving not just fund projects but forge unity, deepen our trust in You, and open avenues of ministry we cannot yet see—scholarships for students, new mission partners, and spaces filled with prayer and praise.
