As you open in prayer, ask the Spirit of God to bring your will and heart into harmony with His. Note any new insights from the sermon. Did anything surprise you? If the Lord spoke to you, what did you hear?

Read Psalm 19 - slowly and aloud. Pause and reflect on any word or phrase that stands out to you. Read it again and pay attention to the declarations of creation. Reflect on a time when creation, beauty has stopped you in your tracks?



What in creation fills you most with a sense of God's glory?
What phrases or thought did you most remember from the sermon, or what questions did the sermon raise for you? Describe a time when you quieted yourself enough to notice God speaking to you (through nature, His Word, or through your desire for God's forgiveness?

LIVING INTO THE WORD

Pastor Bryan outlined three sections of Psalm 19 - Nature speaks (verses 1-6), Scripture instructs (verses 7-11) and God's grace forgives (verses 12-14). Which of these three sections most inspires you? In your life, how does Jesus fulfil your desire for a "Rock" (protector) and "Redeemer" (savior)?

If the sermon message took root deep in your heart and life, what would you do differently this week?
