

GETTING STARTED

1.Begin with 5 minutes of quieting yourself. Surrender to Jesus all the things that clutter your thoughts. Pray, "Holy Spirit, I invite you to come to me. Grant to me the privilege of Your Presence and Visitation."

2.In the sermon, was there a new insight? Something you questioned? Something that spoke to your heart and mind? Share it with your group. If you are in a personal time you may want to journal it for future recall.

LEARNING & LIVING OUT THE SCRIPTURES:

1.Read aloud and slowly the pericope (passage) Luke 19: 28-44.Ask the Spirit of God to teach you and speak to you through it.Wait a couple of minutes and read it again.

2.What stood out to you?

3.Compare and contrast this account with Matthew 21: 1-16.
What is similar? Different? Why the differences?
4.Choose one of the Old Testaments prophecies Pastor Gary referenced; Genesis 49: 8-11, Zechariah 9:9, or Ezekiel 11:23/43: 15. How do these passages encourage your faith in God's promises? In what way is the passage you chose fulfilled on Palm Sunday?



LIVING INTO THE WORD

Why did Jesus weep over Jerusalem? How have you sought peace in someone or something other than Jesus? Can you share about a time when you had a "visitation" i.e., when you experienced the presence of God?

THE EXTRA MILE:

Compare and integrate the truths from Genesis 3: 8-19; Numbers 21: 4-9, and Galatians 3:13 regarding the cursed serpent, the cursed ground, the cursed one hung on a tree, and the crown of thorns. What do these tell you about the cost of your salvation and Jesus' love for you?

Close in prayer for one another and that you may grow in the knowledge of and intimacy with Jesus Christ.
